Dear Madam Secretary,

The undersigned business associations of California wish to congratulate you on your successful leadership in assisting the passage of the CHIPS and Science Act of 2022 (Act). Collectively, we represent the diverse actors within our Innovation Economy, including technology companies, research entities, as well as financial and legal institutions.

Semiconductors provide a myriad of benefits to our nation. They are essential components in products that are vital to America's businesses, such as desktop computers, laptops, tablets and smartphones. In the area of security, we depend on a reliable source of semiconductors and components in order to consistently produce cutting edge microelectronics that enhance military capabilities. Finally, a dependable stream of chips helps to mitigate supply shortages that have reduced domestic manufacturing and idled plants.

California is well-positioned to leverage the Act's incentives and resources to strengthen national manufacturing, R&D and semiconductor workforce training. The Golden State leads the nation with 64,000 semiconductor manufacturing jobs and 643 semiconductor establishments.\(^1\) Further, California is home to numerous national laboratories, internationally renowned universities and a globally diverse tech workforce.
